Note for Bio-Tour Organisers

Thanks for contributing to the 21st Organic World Congress (OWC) by proposing to organise a Bio-Tour.

Bio-tour are:

- A 1 to 3-day event (29 November 1 December 2024), before the OWC main conference (December 2-4, 2024).
- Proposed and organised exclusively by a stakeholder in Taiwan's agriculture or government sector, through a contractual agreement with the OWC Organizers.
- Dealing with a topic relevant for the Organic sector and in line with the congress' objectives or themes.
- Addressing stakeholders from all over the world and not a country or a region only.
- Organised in Taiwan.
- Included and visible on the OWC programme.

Please note that:

- You can submit your contribution **until the 31 July, 2024** by email to papers2024@owc-bio.org
- OWC organisers provide the platform for Bio-Tour organisers to host and promote their own Bio-Tour. There is no extra fee needed to pay OWC organisers.
- The OWC Organisers will assess the proposal and may ask for additional information.
- All proposals will be reviewed by a committee of international and Taiwanese experts. The evaluation will be based on the following criteria:
 - Content Integrity: 30%
 - Relevance to Organic Content: 40%
 - Event Attractiveness: 20%
 - Budget Reasonableness: 10%
- The Bio-Tour admission results will be communicated to all organisers prior to the end of August.
- The organiser may delay notification of admission results due to the review process.

For selected Bio-Tour:

- Bio-Tour organisers will organise the Bio-Tour and will cover the related organisation costs (e.g. working time, flyer, travel costs, invited speakers, sponsoring, interpreters and equipment cost).
- In order to ensure certain specifications, the details of expenses and cost sources should be included in the proposal.
- Bio-Tour organizers are authorized to charge a registration fee to participants of the Bio-Tour.
 Participants will pay this fee directly through OWC online registration and submission platform.
 Subsequently, the collected fees will be transferred to the bio-tour organizers.
- The registration fee may or may not include a fee for food for participants. This will be decided by the organizers of the Bio-Tours.

The primary goal of the Hualien and Taitung Organic Farm Bio-Tour is to immerse visitors in the principles and practices of sustainable agriculture. The itinerary focuses on organic farming techniques, emphasizing their roles in enhancing environmental health and biodiversity conservation. Additionally, it showcases the successes of organic agriculture in Taiwan. By highlighting the critical role of organic farming in maintaining ecological balance and enhancing community well-being, the tour aims to deepen understanding of local food systems.

In addition to showcasing organic agriculture, the tour includes a series of activities designed to provide visitors with first-hand experiences of Taiwan's Indigenous cultures. Participants will have the opportunity to experience unique arts and crafts, and taste foods prepared in traditional ways. These activities not only enhance understanding and appreciation of Indigenous cultures but also deepen



insights into how these cultures are intricately linked with the land. Moreover, interactive and participatory elements of the tour help visitors appreciate the significant role of Indigenous cultures in local ecology and environmental conservation, encouraging respect and support for these traditions and promoting the sustainable coexistence of culture and environment.

- Achievements in Taiwan's Organic Agriculture: Spotlight specific instances of successful
 organic farming initiatives in Taiwan that bolster local economies and community
 welfare.
- 3. Organic Farming's Contribution to Ecological Stability: Delve into how organic agriculture aids in sustaining ecological equilibrium through water conservation, carbon footprint reduction, and preservation of natural ecosystems.
- 4. Incorporation of Indigenous Wisdom in Organic Practices: Consider the traditional ecological knowledge and techniques of Taiwan's Indigenous communities that are woven into contemporary organic farming, boosting sustainability and resilience.
- 5. Organic Agriculture and Community Dynamics: Investigate the synergy between organic farming, local food systems, and community health, focusing on food sovereignty and cultural identity.
- 6. Indigenous Cultural Expression and Artistry: Examine the distinctive arts and crafts of Taiwan's Indigenous cultures, appreciating their role in cultural preservation and ecofriendly tourism.
- 7. Heritage Foods and Culinary Practices: Experience and discuss the culinary traditions of Indigenous communities, appreciating their nutritional benefits and cultural significance.



- 8. Indigenous Roles in Environmental Conservation: Discuss how Indigenous traditions contribute to environmental conservation through age-old land stewardship and biodiversity protection.
- 9. Sustainable Tourism's Challenges and Prospects: Address the hurdles and possibilities for advancing sustainable tourism that honors and sustains local Indigenous cultures and conserves the environment.


